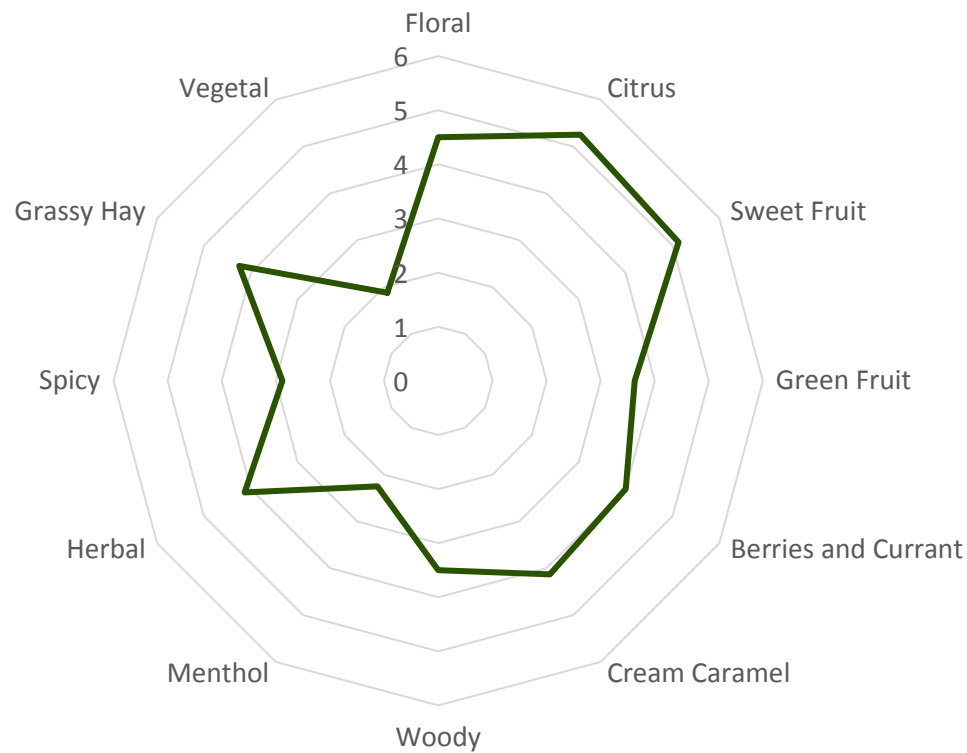

Sasquatch Hops

- **Sasquatch hops is a wild hop that was found by Hops Connect in Pemberton, BC (150 KM north from Vancouver) and is Canada's first proprietary, patented hop – grown in Leamington, Ontario & Chilliwack, BC.**
- **Analytics:**
 - **Alpha-acids: 5% spectro, 7.3% HPLC**
 - **Total oil: 0.8 ml/100 g**
 - **Beta: 8.2%**
 - **Cohumulone: 34.6%**
- **Tasters: N= 10**

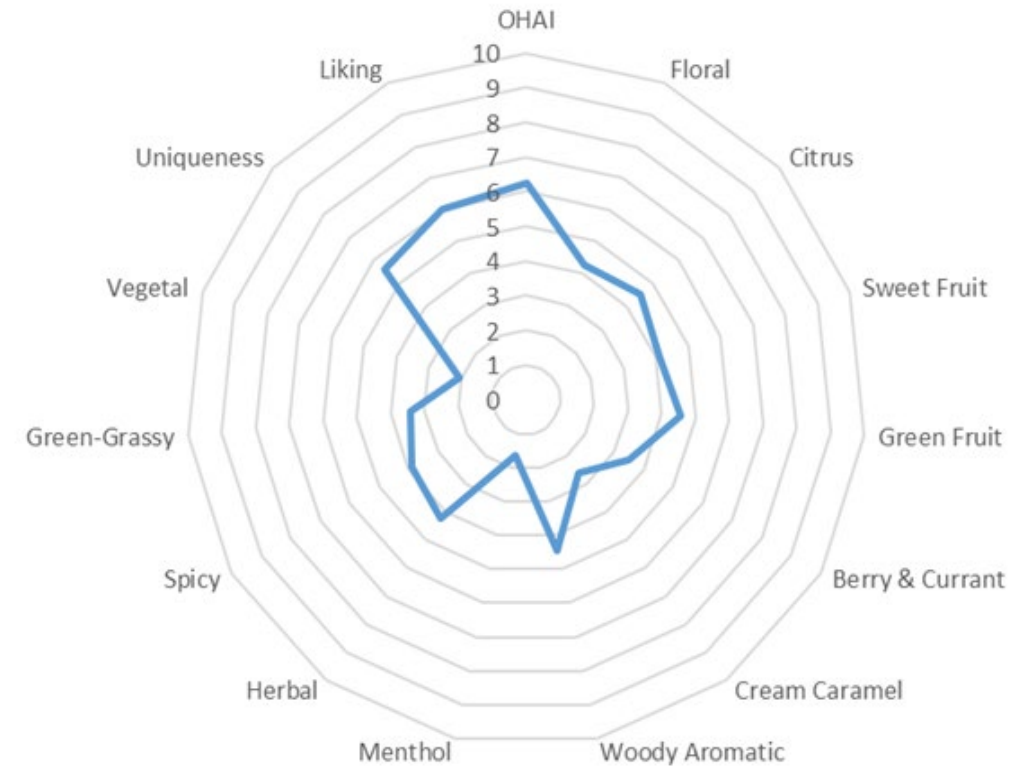

Other comments
Aroma somewhere between US and AUS varieties
Pleasant aroma, but not extremely unique
Similar to Triskel

- Promising hop variety with decent feedback from Simply Hops as well, with average uniqueness for a hop variety
- JIH and BH panels evaluated the hops from two different harvest years similarly with aromas of strong cream caramel, orange, dark berries and hay
- Brewing trials at BH to be completed in two weeks for evaluation in a standard pale ale
